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SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. RATE OF PAY. The entry level salary of a trial court staff person shall be equal to that established in the state pay plan at grade 16—C117.

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31 SECTION 4. FUND CREATED. (a) There is hereby created on the books of the
32 Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a
33 miscellaneous revenue fund to be known as the Trial Court Administrative
