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17 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
18 SERVICES - DIVISION OF CHILD CARE AND
19 EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION APPROPRIATION
20 FOR THE 2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
27 the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood
28 Education for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of
29 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
31 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
32 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
33 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
34 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
35 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
36 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: thirteen (13) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood

 2 Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of
 3 the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood

 34 appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care
 35 and Early Childhood Education, to be payable from the paying account as
 36 determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for grant payments of

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8 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - LOAN GUARANTEES AND GRANTS. There is hereby
9 appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care
10 and Early Childhood Education, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in
11 the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
12 for loan guarantees and grants of the Department of Human Services - Division
13 of Child Care and Early Childhood Education for the fiscal year ending June
14 30, 2010, the following:

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20 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
21 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
22 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
23 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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30 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
31 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
32 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
33 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
34 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
35 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
36 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

1 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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3 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
4 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
5 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
6 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
7 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
9 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
10 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
11 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
12 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
13 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
