The Department of Health and 12 Human Services shall provide funding in an amount not to exceed \$240,000 for 13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 2010 for the Juvenile Ombudsman Program 14 15 described in ACA 16-87-216. Upon request by the Executive Director of the 16 Arkansas Public Defender Commission, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State 17 shall transfer an amount not to exceed \$240,000 for the fiscal year ending 18 June 30, 2009 2010 from an account designated by the Director of the 19 Department of Health and Human Services to the State Central Services Fund as a direct revenue to fund the Juvenile Ombudsman Program. 20 21 22 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 2.3 24 OF FUNDS FOR LOCAL JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITIES. The Chief Fiscal Officer 25 of the State shall transfer funds in an amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal 26 year ending June 30, 2009 2010 from the Department of Health and Human 27 Services - Youth Services Fund Account to the Juvenile Detention Facilities 28 Operating Fund to fund the appropriation to the Department of Finance and 29 Administration - Disbursing Officer for grants for operating expenses of 30 local juvenile detention facilities. 31 The amount of the funds transferred in the fiscal year ending June 30, 32 2009 2010 may be adjusted upon request of the Director of the Department of

1 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH SERVICES - TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT. 3 4 Division of Youth Services is authorized to use the administrative operating 5 account for capital improvements to the physical plant and for the purchase 6 of capital equipment by the Mansfield Youth Services Facility operated by the 7 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Youth Services. The 8 funds shall be held by the Department of Health and Human Services, Division 9 of Youth Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be 10 harvested from land owned by the Division of Youth Services. All funds 11 deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately. The harvesting of 12 timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to finance capital 13 improvements to the physical plant and for the purchase of major capital 14 equipment by the Mansfield Facility from which the timber is sold. 15 The Division of Youth Services shall report all income derived from the sale 16 of timber to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas 17 Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the harvesting and sale of 18 timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas 19 Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state 20 21 purchasing laws. 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 23 2007 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010. 24 25 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 31 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

34

35 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

1	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
2	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
3	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
4	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
5	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
6	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
7	
8	SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
9	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
10	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
11	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
12	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
13	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
14	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
15	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
16	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
17	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
18	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
