## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTIONS  
OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY. There is hereby appropriated, to the Henderson State University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Henderson State University, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,900,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 1319 of 2007, for construction of a business building and renovation of Mooney Hall, in a sum not to exceed \$7,000,000.

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY. There is hereby



appropriated, to the Southern Arkansas University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Southern Arkansas University, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 11 of Act 415 of 2007, for the purchase of science equipment, in a sum not to exceed .....\$20,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1406 of 2007, for expenses of a lignite feasibility study, in a sum not to exceed .....\$95,863.

(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed \$700,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 1319 of 2007, for construction of a University Science Center, in a sum not to exceed .....\$7,000,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 4 of Act 1319 of 2007, for renovation of the Wharton Nursing Building, in a sum not to exceed .....\$500,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) of Section 11 of Act 415 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed ...\$79,919.

SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY - TECH. There is hereby appropriated, to the SAU-Tech, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the SAU-Tech, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) of Section 12 of Act 415 of 2007, for the planning and construction of a Workforce Training Center or other critical maintenance purposes, in a sum not to exceed .....\$57,273.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 30 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources for SAU-Tech, in a sum not to exceed .....\$187,394.

(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 30 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources for the SAU-Tech-Environmental Academy, in a sum not to exceed .....\$50,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 30 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources for the SAU-Tech-Fire Academy, in a sum not to exceed .....\$50,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1634 of 2007, for construction, maintenance and operations, in a sum not to exceed .....\$75,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 30 of Act 1319 of 2007, for construction of a technology/multi-purpose building, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,750,000.

(G) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 30 of Act 1319 of 2007, for expansion/renovation to the existing Environmental Academy classroom building, in a sum not to exceed .....\$400,000.

(H) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 30 of Act 1319 of 2007, for costs associated with the modernization of interior fire simulators at the Fire Training Academy, in a sum not to exceed .....\$250,000.

(I) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 12 of Act 415 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed ....\$3,709.

(J) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 12 of Act 415 of 2007, for various renovation projects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,725.

SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - BEEBE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University - Beebe, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas State University - Beebe, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 13 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed \$259,347.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 13 of Act 1319 of 2007, for construction/renovation of a new space for ASU - Searcy Phase II, in a sum not to exceed ....\$3,000,000.

SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas State University, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,900,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 929 of 2007, for operating expenses, personal services and program support, to replace expiring grants, for the Hemingway-Pfeifer House at Piggott, the Tenant Farmers Museum at Tyronza, the Lakeport Plantation at Lake Village, and the Heritage Center at Jonesboro, in a sum not to exceed .....\$598,406.

(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1319 of 2007, for construction/replacement of Wilson Hall, in a sum not to exceed .....\$16,000,000.

SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - MOUNTAIN HOME.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University - Mountain Home, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas State University - Mountain Home, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1447 of 2007, for construction and other costs of a multi-county Community Development Center or equipping and furnishing a Health Sciences Building, in a sum not to exceed .....\$250,714.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 14 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed \$150,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 14 of Act 1319 of 2007, for construction of a community development center, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,250,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 16 of Act 415 of 2007, for constructing and equipping a Community Development Center, in a sum not to exceed .....\$50,908.

SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - NEWPORT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University - Newport, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas State University - Newport, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1461 of 2007, for costs of constructing, equipping, furnishing, landscaping and other critical costs of a Transportation Technology Center, in a sum not to exceed .....\$135,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 15 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed \$250,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 15 of Act 1319 of 2007, for construction of a transportation technology center, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,350,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 4 of Act 1611 of 2007, to prevent the loss of funding for personal services, operating expenses and economic development grants to support the continuation of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium initiatives, in a sum not to exceed .....\$200,000.

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 18 of Act 415 of 2007, for the Arkansas Tech University Library and other improvements, in a sum not to exceed .....\$86,809.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 18 of Act 415 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed ....\$8,643.

(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed \$651,039.

IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 24 of Act 415 of 2007, for a colorectal screening program at the UAMS Cancer Control and Research Department, in a sum not to exceed .....\$82,295.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 24 of Act 415 of 2007, for Cervical Cancer Research, in a sum not to exceed .....\$18,311.

(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 9 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,250,000.

(J) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 1 of Act 1101 of 2007, for construction, renovation, maintenance, equipment and operational expenses, in a sum not to exceed .....\$700,000.

SECTION 37. REAPPROPRIATION - U OF A - COSSATOT COMMUNITY COLLEGE - TRUST.  
There is hereby appropriated, to the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 29 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed \$150,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 29 of Act 1319 of 2007, for renovation of Technology Center North and Technology Center South, in a sum not to exceed \$350,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 29 of Act 1319 of 2007, for construction of a library/classroom building, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 29 of Act 1319 of 2007, for renovation of Founders Hall, in a sum not to exceed .....\$150,000.

SECTION 42. REAPPROPRIATION - PULASKI TECHNICAL COLLEGE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Pulaski Technical College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Pulaski Technical College, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 26 of Act 760 of 2007, for critical maintenance/equipment/library resources, in a sum not to exceed \$628,921.

(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1720 of 2007, for furnishing, equipping and other costs of the Kanis site Learning Assistance Center, providing learner support and disability support services, in a sum not to exceed ...\$20,062.

(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1515 of 2007, for various maintenance, renovation, equipping, construction, improvement, acquisition, upgrade, repair and operations projects for the Saline County Career Center at Bauxite, in a sum not to exceed .....\$300,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 26 of Act 1319 of 2007, for construction of an aviation maintenance and technology hangar, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

SECTION 43. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable from the Higher Education Projects Development Fund, for the Department of Higher Education, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 9 of Act 415 of 2007, for the development of projects at State Institutions of Higher Education and the payment of project costs and expenses of the issuance of bonds of the Arkansas College Savings General Obligation Bonds Program, in a sum not to exceed .....\$3,432,175.

SECTION 44. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available

1 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
2 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
3 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
4 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
5 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
6 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
7 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
8 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
9 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

10 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing  
11 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
12 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State  
13 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,  
14 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any  
15 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

17 SECTION 45. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
18 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
19 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
20 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
21 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
22 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
23 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
24 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

25  
26 SECTION 46. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
28 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of  
30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
31 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
32 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the  
33 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
34 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
35 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
36 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.



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
