- 15 reimbursable, they must enroll as a provider with the Arkansas Medicaid
- 16 Program and must bill the Arkansas Medicaid Program for all covered services
- 17 for eligible individuals.
- 18 Services which are covered by the Arkansas State Medicaid Program or under
- 19 the Alternative Community Services Waiver Program (ACS) will be utilized to
- 20 the maximum extent possible for any individual who is eligible for Medicaid
- 21 coverage. It is the intent of this section that DDS, as a general policy,
- 22 maximize the use of Medicaid funding available for appropriate services.
- 23 The State shall require each provider funded from this Appropriation for
- 24 community based services, including funding from the Grants/Patient Services
- 25 Line, in the Developmental Disabilities Services Operations appropriation,
- 26 or from the Grants to Community Providers Line, in the Developmental
- 27 Disabilities Services Grants-in-Aid appropriation, to screen each
- 28 individual to whom services are provided for a determination of eligibility
- 29 or ineligibility for Medicaid coverage within thirty days of the first date
- 30 that services are provided. It is the intent of this section to insure that
- 31 wherever possible and appropriate, Medicaid funds are utilized for covered or
- 32 waivered services to individuals who are eligible for coverage under the
- 33 Arkansas Medicaid Program or the ACS Waiver.
- 34 Nothing in this Act shall prevent the Division or any provider from
- 35 extending emergency services when appropriate measures have been taken in a
- 36 timely manner to secure Medicaid eligibility.

- 1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 2 2009 through June 30, <del>2009</del> 2010.

- 4 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 6 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES VOCATIONAL TRAINEES. The Division of
- 7 Developmental Disabilities Services of the Department of Health and Human
- 8 Services is hereby authorized to provide employment opportunities for people
- 9 with developmental disabilities residing at the Human Development Centers who
- 10 work less than a competitive employment level.
- 11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 12 2009 through June 30, <del>2009</del> 2010.

- 14 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANTS IN
- 16 AID CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING FUNDS. Private non-profit community-based
- 17 programs licensed by the Department of Health and Human Services,
- 18 Developmental Disabilities Services, are eligible to receive funds
- 19 appropriated for Grants to Community Providers in the Developmental
- 20 Disabilities Services Grants-in-Aid appropriation of this Act, and as a
- 21 condition of receiving such funds they shall:
- 22 l. Meet minimum standards of performance in the delivery of services to
- 23 people with disabilities as defined by the Department of Health and Human
- 24 Services, Developmental Disabilities Services.
- 2. Supply statistical and financial data to the Department of Health and
- 26 Human Services, Developmental Disabilities Services.
- 27 3. Establish and maintain a sound financial management system in accordance
- 28 with guidelines as set forth by the Department of Health and Human Services.
- 29 4. Establish and maintain community support programs designed to provide
- 30 coordinated care and treatment to ensure ongoing involvement and
- 31 individualized services for persons with disabilities. Every community
- 32 support program shall provide services for persons with disabilities who
- 33 reside within the respective area of the program.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 35 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

- 1 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 3 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
- 4 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized
- 5 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to
- 6 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be
- 7 held by the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of
- 8 Developmental Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber
- 9 that may be harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental
- 10 Disabilities Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked
- 11 separately. The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide
- 12 funds to finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the
- 13 purchase of major capital equipment.
- 14 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all income
- 15 derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and
- 16 the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the harvesting
- 17 of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas
- 18 Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from
- 19 the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state
- 20 purchasing laws.
- 21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 22 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

- 24 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN
- 26 DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.
- 27 (A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of Health
- 28 and Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human
- 29 Development Centers that provide therapy and residential services.
- 30 (B) The Department of Health and Human Services shall continue to accept
- 31 clients for whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are
- 32 needed at state administered Human Development Centers and Community Programs
- 33 licensed by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been
- 34 determined in accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the
- 35 community.
- 36 (C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community based

- l services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community
- 2 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services Grants-in-
- 3 Aid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly benefits community based
- 4 services for persons with developmental disabilities or from the
- 5 appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s)
- 6 directly benefits the Human Development Centers.
- 7 (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of March 1, 2007 from the Grants
- 8 to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services -
- 9 Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with developmental disabilities or
- 10 from any other general revenues as of March 1, 2007, applied as federal
- 11 matching funds for community based services licensed by DDS on March 1, 2007
- 12 be reduced below the approved funding level on March 1, 2007; nor shall the
- 13 general revenues applied as federal matching funds for the Human Development
- 14 Centers be reduced below the approved funding level on March 1, 2007.

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- 16 SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 17 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 18 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 19 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 26 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 27 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 28 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 29 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 30 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 31 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 32 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 33 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 35 SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 36 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

1	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
2	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
3	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
5	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
6	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
7	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
8	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
9	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
