- 34 Disabilities Services Grants-in-Aid appropriation of this Act, and as a
- 35 condition of receiving such funds they shall:
- 1. Meet minimum standards of performance in the delivery of services to

l people with disabilities as defined by the Department of Health and Human

- 2 Services, Developmental Disabilities Services.
- 3 2. Supply statistical and financial data to the Department of Health and
- 4 Human Services, Developmental Disabilities Services.
- 5 3. Establish and maintain a sound financial management system in accordance
- 6 with guidelines as set forth by the Department of Health and Human Services.
- 7 4. Establish and maintain community support programs designed to provide
- 8 coordinated care and treatment to ensure ongoing involvement and
- 9 individualized services for persons with disabilities. Every community
- 10 support program shall provide services for persons with disabilities who
- 11 reside within the respective area of the program.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 13 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

- 15 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 17 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
- 18 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized
- 19 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to
- 20 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be
- 21 held by the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of
- 22 Developmental Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber
- 23 that may be harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental
- 24 Disabilities Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked
- 25 separately. The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide
- 26 funds to finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the
- 27 purchase of major capital equipment.
- 28 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all income
- 29 derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and
- 30 the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the harvesting
- 31 of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas
- 32 Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from

2 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN
- 4 DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.
- 5 (A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of Health
- 6 and Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human
- 7 Development Centers that provide therapy and residential services.
- 8 (B) The Department of Health and Human Services shall continue to accept
- 9 clients for whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are
- 10 needed at state administered Human Development Centers and Community Programs
- 11 licensed by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been
- 12 determined in accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the
- 13 community.
- 14 (C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community based
- 15 services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community
- 16 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services Grants-in-
- 17 Aid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly benefits community based
- 18 services for persons with developmental disabilities or from the
- 19 appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s)
- 20 directly benefits the Human Development Centers.
- 21 (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of March 1, 2007 from the Grants
- 22 to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services -
- 23 Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with developmental disabilities or
- 24 from any other general revenues as of March 1, 2007, applied as federal
- 25 matching funds for community based services licensed by DDS on March 1, 2007
- 26 be reduced below the approved funding level on March 1, 2007; nor shall the
- 27 general revenues applied as federal matching funds for the Human Development
- 28 Centers be reduced below the approved funding level on March 1, 2007.

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- 30 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 31 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 33 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
2	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

4	SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
5	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
11	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
12	
13	SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
16	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
17	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
20	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
