- 9 EQUALIZATION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY MILLAGE. (A) Amendment 79 of the

SALARY OF 3 4 THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. These positions are to be used by the Department of 31 Education in the event that the personal services needs of the Department during the 2007-2009 biennium 2009-2010 fiscal year require additional 32 33 positions, either by title or in number, that are not authorized by the 34 General Assembly in Section 1 of this Act. These positions may also be used 35 to properly classify positions when the Department does not have a vacant 36 position available with the appropriate title and salary level.

- 1 (b) To address needs emerging from statewide education issues and the
- 2 necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the Arkansas
- 3 Department of Education or its successor agency is authorized for the 2007-
- 4 2009 biennium 2009-2010 fiscal year a pool of twenty-five (25) classified
- 5 positions at up to a grade twenty six (26) C130. These positions are to be
- 6 used by the Department of Education in the event that the personal services
- 7 needs of the Department during the 2007-2009 biennium 2009-2010 fiscal year
- 8 require additional positions, either by classification or in number, that are
- 9 not authorized by the General Assembly in Section 1 of this Act. These

These retained funds shall be used exclusively to provide funds for Pulaski County Desegregation Case Costs 18 incurred by the Department of Education and the three (3) Pulaski County 19 20 School Districts under Arkansas Code §6-20-415 and §6-20-416. 21 No portion of the seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) 22 transferred by this Section to the Department of Education Fund Account for 23 Pulaski County Desegregation Case Costs these retained funds shall be 24 expended by the Department of Education without certification by the 25 Commissioner of the Department of Education to the Chief Fiscal Officer of 26 the State and prior approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. 27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 28 2007 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010. 29 SECTION 31. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 30 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 31 32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 33 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

18	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective	
19	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the	
20	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.	
21	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being	
22	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and	
23	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
