SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 14 15 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES - APPORTIONMENT OF FUNDS. Each Community Mental 16 Health Center shall contract with one or more facilities of its choice 17 (excluding Arkansas State Hospital) to provide the inpatient care for indigent patients which the Community Mental Health Center has determined to 18 19 be necessary after prompt screening by the Community Mental Health Center. 20 Payment for patients screened and approved by the Community Mental Health 21 Center who receive care at these inpatient facilities shall be provided to 22 the inpatient facilities at the contract rate unless the funds available for 23 this purpose have been exhausted. Available funding as determined by the 24 Director of the Department of Health and Human Services shall be apportioned 25 on a per capita basis up to a maximum of three dollars and forty-eight cents 26 (\$3.48) per capita for fiscal year 2007 2008 2009-2010. The 2000 federal 27 population census shall be used in determining the population of each 28 catchment area of the fifteen Community Mental Health Centers. All amounts 29 appropriated under this section shall be used by Community Mental Health 30 Centers for residents of each center's catchment area and such funds shall only be accessed as the payment of last resort. 31 32 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

33 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 35 REPORTING. The Division of Behavioral Health Services shall develop an 36 evaluation and monitoring program that will assure all expenditures are made

- l consistent with the intent of these appropriations. As a condition for
- 2 receiving funds under this Act, Community Mental Health Centers (CMHCs) shall
- 3 report quarterly to the Division of Behavioral Health Services the following
- 4 data:
- 5 (1) The number of involuntary commitments and medically indigent admissions
- 6 referred by CMHCs to community-based settings;
- 7 (2) The number of involuntary commitments and medically indigent admissions
- 8 to community-based settings receiving assistance from the acute mental health
- 9 services funds;
- 10 (3) The total number of acute bed days utilized by these involuntary
- 11 commitments;
- 12 (4) The total number of bed days utilized by these medically indigent
- 13 admissions;
- 14 (5) The average length of stay of admissions for these involuntary
- 15 commitments per catchment area;
- 16 (6) The average length of stay of admissions for these medically indigent
- 17 admissions per catchment area;
- 18 (7) The number of medically indigent admissions per catchment area unable to
- 19 receive assistance from the acute mental health services funds due to such
- 20 funds being depleted by prior admissions;
- 21 (8) The number of re-admissions per catchment area for involuntary
- 22 commitments and medically indigent admissions to community-based settings
- 23 receiving assistance from the acute mental health services; and
- 24 (9) Identify any steps taken by CMHCs to improve access to acute mental
- 25 health services.

- 26 The Department of Human Services Division of Behavioral Health Services
- 27 shall report quarterly the data collected from the CMHCs to the House and
- 28 Senate Subcommittees on Public Health.
- 30 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ACUTE
- 32 MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES PER CAPITA LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND INTENT. The
- 33 General Assembly recognizes that the state encouraged the treatment of
- 34 mentally ill residents within community-based settings over two decades ago
- 35 and has taken various approaches to funding since then. The General Assembly
- 36 also recognizes that there are inherent problems within the current public

- 1 mental health system that create disincentives for proper treatment and care.
- 2 The purpose of the Acute Mental Health Services Per Capita appropriation is
- 3 to provide an appropriation for acute mental health services to be utilized
- 4 within community-based settings for the treatment and care of medically
- 5 indigent persons 18 years of age and older and involuntary commitments to the
- 6 public mental health system. The appropriation for acute mental health
- 7 services provided in this Act shall only be used for Community Mental Health
- 8 Centers licensed and certified by the Division of Behavioral Health of the
- 9 Department of Health and Human Services for use within community-based
- 10 settings and facilities.

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- 12 SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 14 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROCEEDS FOR SALES OF TIMBER AND HAY CAPITAL
- 15 IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT. The Division of Behavioral Health Services is
- 16 authorized to use administrative operating account for capital improvements
- 17 to the physical plant, and for the purchase of capital equipment, and for the
- 18 operation of the Arkansas Health Center, operated by the Department of Health
- 19 and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health Services. The funds shall
- 20 be held by the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of
- 21 Behavioral Health Services, from the proceeds of the sale of timber and hay
- 22 that may be harvested from land owned by the Division of Behavioral Health
- 23 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately.
- 24 The harvesting of timber and hay is specifically authorized to provide funds
- 25 to finance capital improvements to the physical plant, for the purchase of
- 26 major capital equipment, and for the operation of the Arkansas Health Center.
- 27 The Division of Behavioral Health Services shall report all income derived
- 28 from the sale of timber and hay to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and
- 29 the Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the harvesting of timber
- 30 and hay shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas
- 31 Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from

1 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ACUTE 2 MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES EMERGENCY RESERVE FUND. Of the total amount 3 4 appropriated for Acute Mental Health Services - Per Capita, two hundred fifty 5 thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 shall 6 first be allocated and made available to the Little Rock Community Mental 7 Health Center for Acute Mental Health Services. The remaining five million 8 five hundred thousand dollars (\$5,500,000) appropriated for the fiscal year 9 shall be allocated and made available to the community mental health centers 10 within community-based settings on a per-capita basis. The Division of 11 Behavioral Health shall work with the community mental health centers to 12 develop an equitable acute care distribution plan which considers utilization of State Hospital beds, clarifying target population, and other pertinent 13 demographic factors to ensure maximum equitable utilization of public funds. 14 15 The Division of Behavioral Health shall report this distribution plan to the 16 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee by July 1, 2008. 17 18 SECTION 28. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 19 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 20 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 21 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 27 28 SECTION 29. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 29 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 30 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 31 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 32 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 33 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 34 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 35 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
