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22 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and 23 24 Transportation for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from 25 26 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time 27 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the 28 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act 29 for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 5 AUTHORITY. The Director of the Department of Education - Division of Public 6 School Academic Facilities and Transportation, with the approval of the Chief 7 Fiscal Officer of the State and after approval by the Arkansas Legislative 8 Council or Joint Budget Committee, is hereby authorized to request necessary 9 appropriation transfers and any other budget related adjustments necessary 10 for the appropriations authorized herein. Furthermore, it is the intent of 11 the General Assembly that the Department of Education - Division of Public 12 School Academic Facilities and Transportation be able to make use of additional contractual services as necessary and that transfers between line 13 14 items and among appropriations are anticipated to accomplish those purposes. 15 Provided, however, that the Department of Education - Division of Public 16 School Academic Facilities and Transportation shall be limited to submitting 17 no more than one transfer request during any fiscal year.

18 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 19 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 20 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 21 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 22 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 23 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 24 has determined that the Department of Education - Division of Public School 25 Academic Facilities and Transportation may operate more efficiently if some 26 flexibility is provided to the Director of the Department of Education -27 Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation authorizing 28 broad powers under the Transfer Authority provision herein. Therefore, it is 29 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 30 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 31 32 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 33 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 34 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 35 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

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3	SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
4	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
5	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
6	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
7	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
8	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
9	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
10	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
11	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

13	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
14	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
15	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
16	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
17	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
18	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
19	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
20	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
21	
22	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
23	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
24	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
25	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
26	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
27	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
28	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
29	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
30	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
31	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
32	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
