1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 2 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 4 5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 8 9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 19 20 the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics are, due to unforeseen circumstances, 21 insufficient for the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics to continue to 22 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will 23 provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics to 24 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act 25 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of 26 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared 27 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the 28 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and 29 after the date of its passage and approval. 30 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 31 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 32 33 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides

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the veto.

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
