BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-10-101(10), concerning the definition of long-term care facility, is amended to read as follows:
(10)(A) "Long-term care facility" means a nursing home, residential care facility, assisted living facility, post-acute head injury retraining and residential care facility, or any other facility which provides long-term medical or personal care.
(B) "Long-term care facility" does not include an adult day care program that provides care and supervision to meet the needs of functionally impaired adults for periods of four (4) or less hours per day in a place other than the adult's home;

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-10-224, concerning licenses for longterm care facilities, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows: (n) The Department of Human Services shall not require a license for an adult day care program that provides care and supervision to meet the needs of a functionally impaired adult for periods of four (4) or less hours per day in a place other than the adult's home.
