19 TO IMPROVE THE SAFETY OF ROADS AND

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26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-804(f), regarding licenses, learner's
29 licenses, and intermediate licenses, is amended to read as follows:

30 (f)(1) The office shall have authority to issue a restricted driver's
31 license, to be known as a "learner's license", to those persons under sixteen
32 (16) years of age.

33 (2) The learner's license shall be issued only to an applicant
34 with a valid instruction permit who is at least fourteen (14) years of age,
35 who has remained free of a serious accident and conviction of a serious
36 traffic violation in the previous six (6) months, and who meets all other



1 licensing examinations requirements of this chapter.

2 (3) The driver with a learner's license shall operate the motor
3 vehicle on the public streets and highways only when:

4 (A) All passengers in the vehicle are wearing their seat
5 belts at all times; and

6 (B) The driver with a learner's ~~permit~~ license is being
7 accompanied by a driver over twenty-one (21) years of age.

8 (4)(A) A driver with a learner's license shall not use a
9 cellular telephone device or other interactive wireless communication device
10 while operating a motor vehicle except for an emergency purpose.

11 (B) As used in this subdivision (f)(4), "emergency
12 purpose" means the driver:

13 (i) Has reason to fear for his or her life, safety,
14 or property;

15 (ii) Reasonably believes that a criminal act may be
16 perpetrated against him or her, his or her property, another person, or
17 another person's property; or

18 (iii) Is reporting:

19 (a) A fire;

20 (b) A traffic accident;

21 (c) A serious road hazard;

22 (d) A medical emergency;

23 (e) A hazardous materials emergency;

24 (f) Another driver who is recklessly,
25 carelessly, or unsafely driving; or

26 (g) Another driver who appears to be driving
27 under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

28 (C) This subdivision (f)(4) is not retroactive and applies
29 only to a person who:

30 (i) Applies for a learner's license after the
31 effective date of this act; and

32 (ii) Is issued a learner's license after the
33 effective date of this act.

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-16-804(g), regarding intermediate
36 licenses, is amended to read as follows:

1 (g)(1)(A) The office shall have authority to issue to those persons
2 under eighteen (18) years of age a restricted driver's license to be known as
3 an "intermediate driver's license".

4 ~~(2)(B)~~ The intermediate driver's license shall be issued
5 only to an applicant with a valid instruction permit or a learner's license
6 who is at least sixteen (16) years of age, who has remained free of a serious
7 accident and conviction of a serious traffic violation for at least the
8 previous six (6) months, and who meets all other licensing examination
9 requirements of this chapter.

10 ~~(3)(C)~~ The driver with an intermediate driver's license
11 shall operate the motor vehicle on the public streets and highways only when
12 all passengers in the vehicle are wearing their seat belts.

13 (D)(i) A driver with an intermediate driver's license
14 shall not use a cellular telephone device or other interactive wireless
15 communication device while operating a motor vehicle except for an emergency
16 purpose.

18 (ii) As used in this subdivision (g)(1)(D),
19 "emergency purpose" means the driver:

20 (a) Has reason to fear for his or her life,
21 safety, or property;

 2 accompanied by a licensed driver who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older
 3 and who is occupying the front passenger seat of the motor vehicle.

4 (ii) As used in this section, "unrelated minor
 5 passenger" means a passenger who is under twenty-one (21) years of age and
 6 who is not:

7 (a) A sibling of the driver;

8 (b) A step-sibling of the driver; or

9 (c) A child who resides in the same household
 10 as the driver.

11 (F) A driver with an intermediate driver's license shall
 12 not operate a motor vehicle on public streets or highways between the hours
 13 of 11:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. unless the driver is:

14 (i) Accompanied by a licensed driver who is twenty-
 15 one (21) years of age or older;

16 (ii) Driving to or from a school activity, church-
 17 related activity, or job; or

18 (iii) Driving because of an emergency.

19 (2) Subdivisions (g)(1)(D)-(F) are not retroactive and apply
 20 only to a person who:

21 (A) Applies for an intermediate license after the
 22 effective date of this act; and

23 (B) Is issued an intermediate license after the effective
 24 date of this act.

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 26 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-16-804(h), regarding restricted
 27 licenses, learner's licenses, and intermediate licenses is repealed.

28 ~~(h) No motor vehicle, nor the operator of a vehicle, nor the~~
 29 ~~passengers of the vehicle shall be stopped, inspected, or detained solely to~~
 30 ~~determine compliance with the requirement set out in this subchapter for~~
 31 ~~wearing a seat belt.~~

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 33 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-16-701(d), regarding the application for
 34 license or instruction permit, is amended to add additional subdivisions to
 35 read as follows:

36 (7) An acknowledgment signed by the applicant for a learner's

1 license or an intermediate driver's license that the applicant is prohibited
2 from using a cellular telephone or other interactive wireless communication
3 device while operating a motor vehicle;

4 (8)(A) An acknowledgment signed by the applicant for an
5 intermediate driver's license that the applicant shall not operate a motor
6 vehicle on public streets or highways with more than one (1) unrelated minor
7 passenger in the motor vehicle unless the applicant is accompanied by a
8 licensed driver who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older.

9 (B) As used in this section, "unrelated minor passenger"
10 means a passenger who is under twenty-one (21) years of age and who is not:

- 11 (i) A sibling of the driver;
12 (ii) A step-sibling of the driver; or
13 (iii) A child who resides in the same household as
14 the driver; and

15 (9)(A) An acknowledgment signed by the applicant for an
16 intermediate driver's license that the applicant shall not operate a motor
17 vehicle on public streets or highways between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and
18 4:00 a.m. unless the applicant is:

- 19 (i) Accompanied by a licensed driver who is twenty-
20 one (21) years of age or older;
21 (ii) Driving to or from a school activity, church-
22 related activity, or job; or
23 (iii) Driving because of an emergency.
