25	Section 1. This	act shall be known and may be cited	d as the "Antony		
26	Hobbs III Act".

28	SECTION 2. Arkar	nsas Code § 6-10-122 is amended to	read as follows:		
29	6-10-122. Automa	ated external defibrillators require	ed.		
30	(a) The State Bo	oard of Education shall promulgate	rules to require		
31	that each school have an automated external defibrillator if funds are				
32	available.				
33	(b)(l) The Depar	rtment of Education shall develop c	<u>riteria for</u>		
34	determining the most ef	ffective method for ensuring that ea	ach public school	=	
35	has an automated extern	nal defibrillator, including withou	t limitation:		
36	<u>(A)</u>	The most effective method for deter	rmining the basis	<u>}</u>	

1	for distributing automated external defibrillators; and		
2	(B) A list of public schools that have purchased an		
3	automated external defibrillator.		
4	(2) As soon as possible, the Department of Education shall		
5	transmit the criteria developed under subdivision (b)(1) of this section to		
6	the Department of Health.		
7	(c)(1) The Department of Health shall purchase a sufficient quantity		
8	of automated external defibrillators to supply each public school in this		
9	state.		
10	(2)(A) Each public school shall receive from the Department of		
11	Health the automated external defibrillator that the public school is		
12	required to have under this section.		
13	(B) The Department of Health shall provide a new automated		
14	external defibrillator to a public school that has purchased an automated		
15	external defibrillator with the public school's own funds when the automated		
16	external defibrillator:		
17	(i) Becomes ineffective or inoperative; or		
18	(ii) Is scheduled to be replaced under the		
19	manufacturer's specifications.		
20	(3) The Department of Health shall distribute to each public		
21	school automated external defibrillators in light of the criteria transmitted		
22	by the Department of Education under subsection (b) of this section.

24	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code title 6, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1 is amended		
25	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
26	6-10-123. School-based automated external defibrillator and		
27	cardiopulmonary resuscitation programs.		
28	(a) The Department of Health shall develop a program for automated		
29	external defibrillator and cardiopulmonary resuscitation training that		
30	incorporates at least the following:		
31	(1) Health care provider oversight, including planning and		
32	review of the selection, placement, and maintenance of automated external		
33	defibrillators;		
34	(2) Appropriate training of anticipated rescuers in the use of		
35	the automated external defibrillator and in cardiopulmonary resuscitation;		
36	(3) Testing of psychomotor skills based on the American Heart		

1	Association scientific guidelines, standards, and recommendations for the use
2	of the automated external defibrillator, as they existed on January 1, 2009,
3	and for providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation as published by the American
4	Heart Association, American Red Cross, or in equivalent course materials, as
5	they existed on January 1, 2009;
6	(4) Coordination with the emergency medical services system;
7	(5) An ongoing quality improvement program to monitor training
8	and evaluate response with each use of the automated external defibrillator;
9	<u>and</u>
10	(6) Assurance that placement and training will be in effect on
11	or before May 31, 2011.
12	(b) All automated external defibrillator and cardiopulmonary
13	resuscitation training developed by the Department of Health shall count
14	fully toward the existing professional development requirements for teachers
15	and school personnel.
16	(c) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to:
17	(1) Implement for students and school personnel in all public
18	schools statewide the standard of care regarding automated external
19	defibrillators and cardiopulmonary resuscitation created in this section;
20	(2) Ensure that each public school requires teachers and school
21	personnel to participate in the training program created under this section;
22	<u>and</u>
23	(3) In cooperation with the Department of Health, ensure that
24	the training program created under this section is readily available to
25	teachers and school personnel statewide at no cost to a public school.
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
