During either fiscal year of the 2007-2009 2009-2011 biennium, If 12 the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary firefighters, dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a wildfire season, 13 14 and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, appropriations 15 may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees and Services 16 to the proper character code for the employment of such personnel. 17 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and 18 19 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be 20 21 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in Section 3 and 31. 22 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for 23 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is 24 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees 25 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the 26 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation 27 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in Section 3 28 and 31.

29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
30 <u>2009</u> through June 30, 2009 <u>2010</u>.

32 SECTION *51*. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO 34 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees 35 to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for 36 expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be

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1 deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to 2 expenditure.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
4 2007 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

6 SECTION 52. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 8 ALLOCATION RESTRICTIONS. For the biennium ending June 30, 2009 2011, The 9 Secretary of the Arkansas Department of Agriculture shall at no time 10 designate general revenue allocations to the State Plant Board, the Arkansas 11 Livestock and Poultry Commission and the Arkansas Forestry Commission at a 12 level less than the revenue distribution provided in the Official Forecast of state general revenue in effect on June 30, 2007 for each of those agencies. 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 14

15 2009 through June 30, 2010.

16

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SECTION 53. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 17 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 18 19 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 20 21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

26

27 SECTION 54. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 30 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 33 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 34 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 35

36 <u>SECTION 55. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the General

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1	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
2	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
3	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
4	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
6	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
7	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
8	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
9	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
10	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
