The Arkansas School for the Deaf is eligible for funding 2 under the Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities Funding Act, §6-20-2501 et seq., the Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities Financing Act of 3 4 2007, §6-20-2601 et seq., and other sources of funding allowed by law. 5 The Arkansas School for the Deaf shall have a separate review and approval 6 process under §6-43-207 and §6-43-303 to receive facilities funding in lieu 7 of the review and approval process for a public school or a public school 8 district under the Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities Funding Act, 9 §6-20-2501 et seq., and the Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities Financing Act of 2007, §6-20-2601 et seq. 10 11 12 SECTION 6. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 13 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 14 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 15 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 16 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 17 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 18 19 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 20 enumerated herein. 4	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General	
5	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the	
6	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the	
7	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of	
8	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in	
9	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective	
10	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the	
11	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.	
12	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
