9 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, 10 to the Department of Education - Arkansas School for the Blind, to be payable 11 from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 12 State, the following:

22 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.
