The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 3 4 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 5 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 6 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 7 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 8 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 9 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the 10 11 President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief 12 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the 13 14 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal 15 year. 16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 17 2007 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010. 18 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.
