16 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL  
17 ARKANSAS APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2009-2010

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
25 the University of Central Arkansas for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the  
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be  
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions  
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
34 101), or its successor.

12 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the  
 13 University of Central Arkansas for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following  
 14 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
 15 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one  
 16 thousand six hundred (1,600) temporary or part-time employees, when needed,  
 17 at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification  
 18 and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
 19 classification.

21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 22 to the University of Central Arkansas, to be payable from the University of  
 23 Central Arkansas Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
 24 University of Central Arkansas for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the

29 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FOOD  
 31 SERVICE. If the University of Central Arkansas cancels the current contract  
 32 for food service and chooses to operate the food service with University  
 33 employees, the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is  
 34 allowed to utilize the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this  
 35 Act, provided he or she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher  
 36 Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior

1 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
3 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

4  
5 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL  
7 ALLOWANCE. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas may  
8 make special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one  
9 sport in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per fiscal  
10 year for any one coach ~~during each year of the 2007-2009 biennium~~. Further,  
11 the Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas is hereby  
12 authorized to make additional payments to head coaches at the University of  
13 Central Arkansas from revenues generated by contracts with vendors of  
14 athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such amounts as may be  
15 established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the coaches of  
16 consulting and other obligations pursuant to contracts between the University  
17 and such vendors. Such additional payments to head coaches shall not be  
18 considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the maximum  
19 salaries established for such coaches by the Act. Nothing in this section  
20 shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the authority granted elsewhere in  
21 Arkansas statutes for the payment of allowances or bonuses to coaches at the  
22 University of Central Arkansas. Further, if the special allowance funds  
23 authorized herein are utilized, the University of Central Arkansas shall  
24 report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact  
25 disposition of those special allowance funds.

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
27 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

28  
29 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
31 MEMBERSHIP AUTHORIZATION. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central  
32 Arkansas is hereby authorized to enact voluntary payroll deductions for  
33 employees using on-campus programs and facilities. All such deductions shall  
34 be entirely voluntary in nature, shall require written authorization from  
35 each participant electing to use such deductions and shall not be made on a  
36 pre-tax basis. Nothing in this section shall be construed to reduce or

1 eliminate the payroll regulations established elsewhere in Arkansas Statutes.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
3 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

4  
5 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
7 CONSTRUCTION. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas  
8 shall be included as an exempt institution related to projects exceeding  
9 \$5,000,000 provided that the institution shall have adopted policies and  
10 procedures involving the awarding and oversight of the contracts for design  
11 and construction services in compliance with State Law.

12  
13 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TUITION  
15 REIMBURSEMENT. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas  
16 shall be authorized to reimburse tuition, fees, and other educational related  
17 expenses of current faculty who seek additional education levels that will  
18 benefit the university in meeting accreditation and professional standards.  
19 Reimbursement shall be authorized only when the reimbursement request has  
20 been documented by the institution to meet critical shortage instructional  
21 areas.

22  
23 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
25 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged  
26 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the  
27 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief  
28 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December  
29 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or  
30 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during  
31 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.  
32 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the  
33 President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or  
34 upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief  
35 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the  
36 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal

1 year.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
3 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

4  
5 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
6 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
7 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
8 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
10 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
11 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
12 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
13 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
14 with in disbursement of said funds.

15  
16 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
18 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
23 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24  
25 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
27 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of  
29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
30 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the  
32 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
33 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
34 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
35 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.

36
