## Subtitle

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18 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS -  
19 ITS VARIOUS DIVISIONS AND THE ARKANSAS  
20 ARCHEOLOGICAL SURVEY APPROPRIATION FOR  
21 THE 2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - VARIOUS DIVISIONS AND THE ARKANSAS  
27 ARCHEOLOGICAL SURVEY. There is hereby established for the University of  
28 Arkansas - Various Divisions and the Arkansas Archeological Survey for the  
29 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees  
30 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
31 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or  
32 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
33 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
34 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
35 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
36 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and



1 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

16 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
17 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
