The number of members shall be determined by agreement between the 4 Chair of the Senate Interim Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor 5 and the Chair of the House Interim Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and 6 Labor.

7 (2) The Chair of the Senate Interim Committee on Public Health,
8 Welfare, and Labor and the Chair of the House Interim Committee on Public
9 Health, Welfare, and Labor shall appoint the membership pursuant to procedure
10 agreed upon by the chairs.

11 (3) The task force shall include members of the General Assembly 12 and members of the public.

13 (4) The cochairs of the task force shall be members of the
14 General Assembly. One (1) cochair shall be a member of the Senate and one (1)
