1	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
2	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that tourism could add much needed	
3	additional revenue to the state due to the economic downturn of the state,	
4	that the current deadline for the Director of the Department of Economic	
5	Development to designate a lodging facility with certain restrictions as an
