1	(a) $\underline{(1)}$ In school elections, the school districts in the county shall	
2	reimburse the county for the entire cost of the election <u>less expenses</u>	
3	incurred for election officials at individual polling places, with each	
4	school district's share of the total being determined by multiplying the	
5	total cost of the election by a fraction, the numerator of which is the	
6	number of votes cast in the specific school election and the denominator of	
7	which is the total number of votes cast in the entire election.	
8	(2) Expenses incurred for election officials at individual	
9	polling places shall be paid by the school district in which the polling	
10	place is located.
