33	This subchapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Fair Disclosure	2
34	to Employers, Insurance Companies, and others of Payments For Pharmacists'	=

1	<u>4-88-802. Definitions.</u>
2	As used in this subchapter:
3	(1) "Pharmacy benefits manager" or "PBM" means an entity that
4	administers or manages a covered entity's pharmacy benefits plan or program;
5	(2)(A) "Covered entity" means:
6	(i) A hospital service corporation, medical service
7	corporation, hospital and medical service corporation, insurer, health
8	coverage plan, or health maintenance organization;
9	(ii) A health program administered by the state or
10	any agency or department of the state; and
11	(iii) An employer, labor union, or other group of
12	persons.
13	(B) "Covered entity" does not include:
14	(i) A health plan that provides coverage only for
15	accidental injury, specified disease, hospital indemnity; or
16	(ii) Medicare supplement, disability income, long-
17	term care or other limited benefit health insurance policies and contracts;
18	(3) "Pharmacy benefits plan or program" means any plan or
19	program that furnishes, covers the cost of, or otherwise provides for
20	pharmacist services to individuals who reside or are employed in this state;
21	(4) "Pharmacist" means the same as defined in § 17-92-101;
22	(5) "Pharmacist services" means products, goods, or services
23	provided as a part of the practice of pharmacy as defined in § 17-92-101 to
24	individuals who reside or are employed in this state; and
25	(6) "Pharmacy" means the same as defined in § 17-92-101.
26	
27	4-88-803. Required practices.
28	(a) A PBM, when seeking payment or reimbursement for pharmacist
29	services or reporting expenditures for pharmacist services, shall itemize by
30	individual claim:
31	(1) The amount actually paid or to be paid to the pharmacy or
32	pharmacist for the pharmacist services;
33	(2) The identity of the pharmacy or pharmacist actually paid or
34	to be paid; and
35	(3) The prescription number or other identifier of the
36	pharmacist services.

1	(b) A PBM shall pay the amounts it receives for pharmacist services to
2	the pharmacies or pharmacists that provided the pharmacist services.
3	(c) This section does not:
4	(1) Require a PBM to set specific fees, rates, or schedules for
5	payment for pharmacist services;
6	(2) Prohibit a PBM from charging for any services in addition to
7	pharmacist services; or
8	(3) Require a PBM to pay a pharmacy or pharmacist more on any
9	claim than the amount disclosed under subdivision (a)(1) of this section.

11	4-88-804. Enforcement.
12	A violation of this subchapter is a deceptive and unconscionable trade
13	practice under the Deceptive Trade Practices Act, § 4-88-101 et seq.
