1	(1) Purchase or possess an emergency vehicle light or siren with		
2	a purpose to install or use the emergency vehicle light or siren on a motor		
3	vehicle that reasonably appears to be or that mimics a law enforcement

5	(2) Install or use an emergency vehicle light or siren on a		
6	motor vehicle that reasonably appears to be or that mimics a law enforcement

21	(2) "Law enforcement vehicle" means any vehicle owned or		
22	operated by a law enforcement agency; and		
23	(3) "Siren" means an acoustic or electronic device producing a		
24	loud or wailing sound as a signal or warning.		
25	(d) A violation of this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
