AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE OF SHOTGUNS, RIFLES,
AND AMMUNITION TO OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENTS; FOR THE
PURCHASE OF SHOTGUNS, RIFLES, AND AMMUNITION BY
ARKANSAS RESIDENTS IN OTHER STATES; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

CONCERNING THE SALE OF SHOTGUNS, RIFLES,
AND AMMUNITION TO OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENTS
AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF SHOTGUNS,
RIFLES, AND AMMUNITION BY ARKANSAS
RESIDENTS IN OTHER STATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-73-125 is amended to read as follows:

5-73-125. Interstate sale and purchase of shotguns, rifles, and
ammunition.

(a) The sale of shotguns and rifles and ammunition in this state to
residents of ~~adjacent~~ other states is authorized ~~pursuant to~~ under
regulations issued by the ~~Secretary of the Treasury~~ Attorney General of the
United States under the Federal Gun Control Act of 1968, 18 U.S.C. § 921 et
seq., as ~~the act is~~ in effect on ~~March 4, 1969~~ January 1, 2009.

(b) A resident of this state ~~is permitted to~~ may purchase a rifle,
shotgun, or ammunition in ~~an adjacent~~ another state as expressly authorized
~~pursuant to~~ under the regulations issued under the Federal Gun Control Act of
1968, 18 U.S.C. § 921 et seq., as in effect on ~~March 4, 1969~~ January 1, 2009.
