18	emergency exit window on a Type D bus the following notification:
19	"IT IS A VIOLATION OF ARKANSAS LAW TO PASS A SCHOOL BUS FROM ANY DIRECTION
20	WHEN IT IS STOPPED TO LOAD OR UNLOAD A CHILD".
21	(b) A school bus that is purchased on or after January 1, 2011, shall
22	be equipped with either:
23	(1) A notice printed or otherwise displayed as provided under
24	subsection (a) of this section; or
25	(2) An electronic warning device as defined under § 6-19-124.
