## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING GRANDPARENT AND GREATGRANDPARENT VISITATION RIGHTS SUBSEQUENT TO THE ADOPTION OF THE CHILD BY A STEPPARENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 9-13-103(b), concerning visitation rights of grandparents and great-grandparents when the child is in the custody of a parent, is amended to read as follows:
(b)(1) A grandparent or great-grandparent may petition a circuit court of this state for reasonable visitation rights with respect to his or her grandchild or grandchildren or great-grandchild or great-grandchildren under this section if:
(1)(A) The marital relationship between the parents of the child has been severed by death, divorce, or legal separation;
(2)(B) The child is illegitimate and the petitioner is a maternal grandparent of the illegitimate child; or
(3)(C) The child is illegitimate, the petitioner is a paternal grandparent of the illegitimate child, and paternity has been
established by a court of competent jurisdiction.

(2) The right of a petitioning grandparent or great-grandparent is not terminated by the subsequent adoption of the child by a steparent.
