11 LICENSE UNTIL ALL OUTSTANDING WARRANTS HAVE BEEN  
12 DISPOSED OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW; AND FOR  
13 OTHER PURPOSES.

16 TO DISALLOW THE RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S  
17 LICENSE UNTIL ALL OUTSTANDING WARRANTS  
18 HAVE BEEN DISPOSED OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH  
19 THE LAW.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-901(b), concerning the expiration  
25 and renewal of driver's licenses, is amended to read as follows:

26 (b)(1) Every Except as provided in subdivision (b)(2) of this section,  
27 a driver's license shall be renewable on or before its expiration upon  
28 completion of an application, payment of the fees designated in § 27-16-801,  
29 and passage of the eyesight test required in § 27-16-704 and shall be renewed  
30 without other examination, unless the commissioner has reason to believe that  
31 the licensee is no longer qualified to receive a license.

32 (2)(A) An individual who has an outstanding warrant issued by a  
33 court of this state for his or her arrest cannot renew his or her driver's  
34 license until the outstanding warrant has been disposed of in accordance with  
35 the law.

36 (B) The Director of the Department of Finance and



1 Administration and the Director of the Arkansas Crime Information Center are  
2 authorized to promulgate rules to effectuate the purpose of subdivision  
3 (b)(2)(A) of this section.

5 SECTION 2. Effective Date. Section 1 of this act is effective  
6 beginning January 1, 2010.
