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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 37 of the Regular Session of 2009 is hereby
24 amended to read as follows:

25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
26 the Arkansas Home Inspector Registration Board, to be payable from the
27 Arkansas Home Inspectors Registration Fund, for various operation expenses of
28 the Arkansas Home Inspector Registration Board for the fiscal year ending
29 June 30, 2010, the following:

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35 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
36 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the



1 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
2 effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is
3 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this
4 Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular
5 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its
6 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper
7 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
8 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
9 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
10 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
11 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
12 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
13 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
14 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
15 the veto.

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
