11 AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CIRCUIT JUDGESHIP IN THE
12 FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY The Judicial Resources Assessment Committee
22 of the Arkansas Judicial Council has reviewed the caseloads of various
23 judicial districts and has determined that to ensure the smooth, efficient,
24 and timely administration of justice an additional circuit judgeship is
25 needed in the Fourth Judicial District. This act authorizes the
26 establishment of one (1) additional circuit judgeship, articulates the
27 election process of the additional circuit judge, and identifies various
28 resources that will be available.
29

30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 13, Subchapter 12 is
31 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

32 16-13-1208. Additional judgeship.

33 (a) There is created in the Fourth Judicial District an additional
34 circuit judgeship.

35 (b) The qualified electors of the district shall elect the additional
36 circuit judge created by subsection (a) of this section at the 2010



1 general election for nonpartisan judicial offices held on the same dates and
2 at the same times and places as the preferential primary election to take
3 office on January 1, 2011.

4 (c)(1) The additional circuit judge shall be elected from the
5 district, shall satisfy the same qualifications for holding office, and shall
6 receive the same salary, expenses, and other allowances as provided by law
7 for judges of the circuit courts.

8 (2) The circuit judge shall serve for elected terms of six (6)
9 years.

10 (d) The counties that compose the Fourth Judicial District shall
11 provide courtroom and office facilities and supplies for the judge of the
12 circuit judgeship created by subsection (a) of this section which shall be
13 paid out of the county treasury in the same manner as other demands against
14 the county and out of funds appropriated by the quorum court of the county
15 for these purposes.

16 (e) There shall be provided for the judge of the circuit judgeship
17 created by subsection (a) of this section a court reporter and a trial court
18 administrative assistant whose salaries shall be fixed and paid in the manner
19 provided by law for court reporters and trial court administrative assistants
20 of the circuit courts of this state.
