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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
28 the Department of Rural Services the following maximum number of regular
29 employees which shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions
30 authorized in Section 1 of Act 16 of 2009 and whose salaries shall be
31 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
32 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
33 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
34 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
35 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
36 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions



1 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
 2 101), or its successor.

18 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - WILDLIFE RECREATION FACILITIES PILOT PROGRAM.
 19 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Rural Services, to be
 20 payable from the Wildlife Recreation Facilities Fund, for personal services
 21 and operating expenses of the Department of Rural Services for the fiscal
 22 year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

39 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 40 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 41 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 42 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 43 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 44 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 45 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
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1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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4 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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13 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
