19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 1-4-126 is amended to read as follows to  
22 include general and permanent language from Acts 2007, No. 156:

23 1-4-126. State butterfly.

24 (a) The Diana fritillary butterfly is designated the official  
25 butterfly of the State of Arkansas.

26 (b)(1) This section does not require a state agency or office to  
27 republish a publication or brochure in order to list or display the state  
28 butterfly.

29 (2) A state agency or office may include the information  
30 concerning the state butterfly in future publications or brochures or in a  
31 scheduled update to a publication or brochure.

32 (c) This section does not grant a protected status to the Diana  
33 fritillary butterfly.

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 1-4-127 is amended to read as follows to  
36 include general and permanent language from Acts 2007, No. 513:



1 1-4-127. State grain.

2 (a) Rice is designated the official grain of the State of Arkansas.

3 (b)(1) This section does not require a state agency or office to  
4 republish a publication or brochure in order to list or display the state  
5 grain.

6 (2) A state agency or office may include the information  
7 concerning the state grain in future publications or brochures or in a  
8 scheduled update to a publication or brochure.

10 SECTION 3. The enactment and adoption of this act shall not repeal,  
11 expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular session of the 87th  
12 General Assembly. All such acts shall have full effect and, so far as those  
13 acts intentionally vary from or conflict with any provision contained in this  
14 act, those acts shall have the effect of subsequent acts and as amending or  
15 repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987.
