19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-144-103 is amended to read as follows to

 32 act, those acts shall have the effect of subsequent acts and as amending or
 33 repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987.
