1	SECTION 9. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
2	SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFER. Immediately
3	upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
4	shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor
5	of the State the sum of sixty one million forty-nine thousand one hundred
6	twelve dollars (\$61,049,112) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund
7	to the General Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund to be
8	distributed as all other general revenue.

11	SECTION 10. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR
12	PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNCLAIMED PROPERTY
13	FUND TRANSFER. (a) Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the
14	Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the Auditor of State to
15	deposit the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) from moneys collected
16	pursuant to Arkansas Code 18-28-213 and which were deposited into the
17	<u>Unclaimed Property Proceeds Trust Fund into the General Revenue Fund Account</u>
18	of the State Apportionment Fund to be distributed as all other general
19	revenue. (b) The deposit shall be made notwithstanding the provisions of
20	<u>Arkansas Code 18-28-213 (c)(2).</u>

22	SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by
23	the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that changes in the state's
24	fiscal laws must take effect at the beginning of the fiscal year, that if the
25	current legislative session is extended such that the 90 day period is later
26	than July 1, 2009 the changes will not be timely. Therefore, an emergency is
27	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
28	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
29	on July 1, 2009.
