23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - NECROPSY ROOM IMPROVEMENTS. There is hereby
26 appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable from the
27 Livestock and Poultry Special Revenue Fund, the following:

28 (A) For construction, renovation and equipping of the Necropsy Room at the
29 Livestock and Poultry Diagnostic Lab, the sum of\$75,000.
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31 *SECTION 2. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas*
32 *Agriculture Department for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum*
33 *number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the*
34 *provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code*
35 *§§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.*
36 *Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual*



1 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
 2 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
 3 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
 4 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
 5 or its successor.

14 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas
 15 Agriculture Department, to be payable from the Livestock and Poultry Special
 16 Revenue Fund, for personal services of the Arkansas Agriculture Department -
 17 Livestock and Poultry for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
 18 following:

26 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
 27 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
 28 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
 29 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
 30 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
 31 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
 32 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
 33 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
 34 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
 35 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
 36 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall

1 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

2 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
3 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
4 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
5 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
6 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
7 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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9 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
10 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
19 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
20 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
23 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
24 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
25 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
