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24	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - EGG GRADING PROGRAM. There is hereby
25	appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable from the
26	Poultry and Egg Grading Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of
27	the Arkansas Agriculture Department - Livestock and Poultry which shall be
28	supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 10 of Act
29	1242 of 2007, the following:

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6	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized	
7	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds	i
8	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the	
9	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and	
10	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary	•
11	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal	
12	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated b	У
13	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall b	е
14	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.	
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16	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly	
17	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained	d
18	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this a	ct
19	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations	
20	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by	
21	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral	
22	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or	
23	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.	
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25	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General	
26	Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of	·
27	the Arkansas Agriculture Department are, due to unforeseen circumstances,	
28	insufficient for the Arkansas Agriculture Department to continue to provide	<u>:</u>
29	essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provi	de
30	the necessary monies for the Arkansas Agriculture Department to continue su	.ch
31	services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work	
32	irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential	
33	governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist	
34	and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	
35	peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after t	he
36	date of its passage and approval.	

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     If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
     effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
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     may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
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     overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
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     the veto.
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
