19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-10-309(a)(1)(A)(iv) is amended to read
22 as follows to change the punctuation to conform to Code style:

23 (iv) The Attorney General shall be allowed to
24 recover costs and attorney's fees associated with the civil suit from the
25 town, county, or city found to have failed to be in ~~compliance; and~~
26 compliance.

28 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 16-10-310(b) is amended to read as follows
29 in light of the repeal of § 1-2-305:

30 (b) The following state programs and agencies shall be paid at an
31 annual rate, at not less than the amounts certified by the Department of
32 Finance and Administration which were received by the program or agency in
33 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, in a monthly installment of at least
34 one-twelfth (1/12) of the annual appropriation provided for each agency for
35 this purpose from the State Administration of Justice Fund:

33 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 16-17-917 [Effective until January 1, 2012]
34 is amended to read as follows:

35 16-17-917. Phillips County District Court. [Effective until January
36 1, 2012.]

1 (a)(1) Phillips County shall have one (1) district court with two (2)
2 departments located in Helena-West Helena.

3 (2) One (1) judge ~~for~~ shall be assigned to each department.

4 (b) The judges of the Phillips County District Court shall be elected
5 countywide.

6 (c) The Phillips County District Court shall have countywide
7 jurisdiction.

8
9 SECTION 4. The enactment and adoption of this act shall not repeal,
10 expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular session of the 87th
11 General Assembly. All such acts shall have full effect and, so far as those
12 acts intentionally vary from or conflict with any provision contained in this
13 act, those acts shall have the effect of subsequent acts and as amending or
14 repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987.
