19	17-106-205. Emerging categories of physician extenders.
20	(a) For purposes of this section:
21	(1) "Imaging sciences" means those disciplines utilizing
22	electromagnetic or sound energies in the diagnosis of human disease; and
23	(2) "Therapeutic disciplines" means those disciplines employing
24	sealed and unsealed radioactive sources in the treatment of human disease.
25	(b) The Arkansas State Medical Board shall adopt rules for the
26	licensure or certification of emerging categories of physician extenders in
27	the imaging sciences and therapeutic disciplines.
28	(c) This section does not grant authority to the board to regulate
29	other licensed practitioners of the healing arts, including practitioners
30	with radiologic technology licenses as currently defined and regulated by the
