1	(1) "Administrative rights" means permissions and powers,
2	including without limitation the permissions and powers to access, alter,
3	copy, download, read, record, upload, write, or otherwise manipulate and
4	maintain records kept by a county official;
5	(2) "Electronic record" means a record created, generated, sent,
6	communicated, received, or stored by electronic means; and
7	(3)(A) "Public records" means writings, recorded sounds, films,
8	tapes, electronic or computer-based information, or data compilations in any
9	medium required by law to be kept or otherwise kept and that constitute a
10	record of the performance or lack of performance of official functions that
11	are or should be carried out by a public official or employee, a governmental
12	agency, or other agency wholly or partially supported by public funds or
13	expending public funds. All records maintained in county offices or by county
14	employees within the scope of employment are public records.
15	(B) "Public records" does not mean software acquired by
16	purchase, lease, or license.
17	(c)(l) A county official required by law to maintain public records
18	and who in the normal performance of official duties chooses to keep and
19	maintain the records in an electronic record retains administrative rights
20	and complete access to all the records.
21	(2) A contract between a county and an electronic record
22	provider shall include the information under subdivision (c)(l) of this
23	section.

25	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
26	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that some counties and county
27	officials that have public records stored in an electronic record may not
28	have complete access and control of the records and that this act is
29	necessary because the lack of control has led or will lead to lawsuits of
30	which the basis is the county officeholder's inability to access the county's
31	own records. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
32	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall
33	become effective on:
34	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
35	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
36	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
