8	(a)(1) After January 1, 2010, a person shall not collect a fee for		
9	performing services as a mold investigator in the state of Arkansas, nor hold		
10	himself or herself out as a mold investigator without being licensed to		
11	perform a mold investigation by the State Plant Board.		
12	(2) The board may impose a fine not to exceed one thousand		
13	dollars (\$1,000) per incident for a violation of this section.		
14	(b)(1) A person licensed under this chapter shall satisfactorily		
15	demonstrate one (1) or more of the following qualification criteria:		
16	(A) Certification as a Certified Industrial Hygienist by		
17	the American Board of Industrial Hygiene;		
18	(B) Certification as a Certified Microbial Consultant by		
19	the American Indoor Air Quality Council;		
20	(C) Successful completion of at least 20 (twenty) hours of

11	(a) The State Plant Board shall administer and enforce the licensure		
12	of mold investigators in this state.		
13	(b) The board shall adopt rules necessary to implement this chapter,		
14	including without limitation:		
15	(1) Initial registration and annual renewal procedures for		
16	licensure of mold inspectors;		
17	(2) Collection of an annual license fee not to exceed one		
18	hundred fifty dollars (\$150) per person;		
19	(3) Collection of fines under § 17-54-103;		
20	(4) Establishment of standards of practice and a code of ethics		
21	for mold inspectors; and		
22	(5) Enforcement of procedures in accordance with the Arkansas
