22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-804(b)(2)(A), regarding the waiver of
25 age restrictions to apply for a driver's license, learner's license, and
26 intermediate license, is amended to read as follows:

27 (2)(A)(i) Upon the showing of need, the The office may, ~~upon~~
28 ~~showing of need,~~ waive any age restriction set forth in this chapter.

29 (ii) However, every driver under eighteen (18) years
30 of age is at a minimum subject to the restrictions found in subsection (g) of
31 this section.
