17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 15-21-206(7), concerning the powers and
20 duties of the State Surveyor to receive and refer complaints, is amended to
21 read as follows:

22 (7) To:

23 (A) Prescribe reasonable rules ~~and regulations~~ not
24 inconsistent with law designed to establish uniform professional surveying
25 and mapping methods and standards in this state;

26 (B) Disseminate the rules ~~and regulations~~ to those engaged
27 in the profession of land surveying; and

28 (C) ~~Receive and refer any complaint against a surveyor to~~
29 ~~the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors~~
30 ~~which shall have the authority to investigate complaints and to determine the~~
31 ~~appropriate action, if any~~ Administer the rules by referring evidence of
32 violations to the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and
33 Land Surveyors under subdivision (9) of this section;

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 15-21-206(9), concerning the powers and
36 duties of the State Surveyor to participate in the review of a survey, is

2 (9) ~~To participate in the review of a survey when requested by~~
3 ~~the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors~~
4 ~~and return the results of the review to the board for appropriate action, if~~
5 ~~any~~ To receive and investigate complaints against any surveyor and to present
6 the results from the investigation of complaints to the board for any action
