## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO CREATE THE ARKANSAS ELECTRONIC RECORDS  
STUDY COMMISSION TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE  
GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON AMENDING THE FREEDOM OF  
INFORMATION ACT OF 1967; TO SPECIFICALLY ADDRESS  
THE ISSUE OF BULK COMMERCIAL ACCESS TO ELECTRONIC  
OR COMPUTERIZED RECORDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO CREATE THE ARKANSAS ELECTRONIC  
RECORDS STUDY COMMISSION AND TO ADDRESS  
THE ISSUE OF BULK COMMERCIAL ACCESS  
UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT OF  
1967.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to create the Arkansas  
Electronic Records Study Commission to make recommendations to the General  
Assembly on amending the Freedom of Information Act of 1967 and to  
specifically address the issue of bulk commercial access to electronic or  
computerized records.
