19	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODI	FY. Intent. It is the	intent of the General	
20	Assembly that hunting and fishing in Arkansas is important to the culture and			
21	history of Arkansas and to the economic growth of the state. It is incumbent			
22	upon the General Assembly to	ensure that all Arkansa	ns have the opportunity	
23	to hunt and fish in this state and that license fees along with other factors			
24	implemented by the Arkansas S	State Game and Fish Comm	ission has begun to limit	
25	the number of persons taking	part in this endeavor.	The General Assembly	
26	also finds that Freddie Black	t, the current chair of	the Arkansas State Game	
27	and Fish Commission, and the	other commissioners sho	uld strive in their	
28	duties to ensure that hunting	and fishing opportunit	ies are made available to	
29	all Arkansans.

19	fishing licenses, is amended to read as follows:		
20	15-42-107. Nonresident fishing license generally.		
21	(a)(1) It shall be unlawful for any nonresident person to take or		
22	attempt to take fish in this state in any manner without first procuring a		
23	nonresident fishing license.		
24	(2) The nonresident annual fishing license fee shall be five		
25	dollars (\$5.00) one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50).		
26			
27	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 15-42-108(a), concerning nonresident three-		
28	day fishing license, is amended to read as follows:		
29	15-42-108. Nonresident three-day fishing license.		
30	(a) The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission shall issue or cause		
31	to be issued a three-day fishing license to any nonresident of the state,		
32	upon application therefor and the payment of a fee of three dollars and fifty		
33	cents (\$3.50) one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50).		
34			
35	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 15-42-110 is amended to read as follows:		
36	15-42-110. Three-day fishing license.		

The maximum fee for a three-day fishing license for any resident in the State of Arkansas who is sixteen (16) years of age or older, but less than sixty-five (65) years of age, shall not exceed six dollars and fifty cents (\$6.50) one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) each.
