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4	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
5	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that schools are still in session		
6	and will be active in fundraising activities throughout the remainder of the		
7	school year. In order to capture the maximum financial gain from these		
8	events and increase the profits from the sales of goods or services that		
9	ultimately are invested in the school, this act should be immediately		
10	enacted. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
