23	(a) There is hereby created a commission to be known as the "Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission".	.1
24	(b) The commission shall consist of twenty-six (26) members:	
25	(1) A representative of the Governor's Office, to be appointed	ad
26	by the Governor and to serve at the pleasure of the Governor;	-u
27	(2) Four (4) members to be appointed by and serve at the	
28	pleasure of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;	
29	(3) Four (4) members to be appointed by and serve at the	
30	pleasure of the Speaker of the House of Representatives;	
31	(4) Thirteen (13) members of the general public, to be appoin	ated
32	by the Governor, who shall be residents of the state, shall represent the	
33	various geographical areas of the state and various civic, social, religio	ous,
34	educational, labor, business, and artistic organizations, and shall be	
35	committed to resolving conflict and to upholding the humanitarian philosop	phy
36	of Dr. King; and	

1	(5) Four (4) members of the general public, to be appointed by
2	the Governor, who shall be residents of the state between the ages of sixteen
3	(16) and nineteen (19), no more than one (1) of whom shall reside in the same
4	congressional district.
5	(c)(1) Members representing the general public appointed by the
6	Governor shall serve for a term of three (3) years.
7	(2) No member of the commission shall serve more than two (2)
8	consecutive terms.
9	(3) Vacancies in the membership shall be filled for the balance
10	of the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointments were
11	made.
12	(d)(1) The Governor shall designate one (1) cochair of the commission
13	from the general public membership.
14	(2) The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the
15	President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall jointly designate one (1) cochair
16	of the commission.
17	(b) The commission shall consist of thirteen (13) members as follows:
18	(1)(A) Five (5) members appointed by the Governor.
19	(B) The Governor shall appoint one (1) member from each
20	Congressional district;
21	(2)(A) Four (4) members appointed by the President Pro Tempore
22	of the Senate.
23	(B) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint
24	one (1) member from each Congressional district; and
25	(3)(A) Four (4) members appointed by the Speaker of the House
26	of Representatives.
27	(B) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
28	appoint one (1) member from each Congressional district.
29	(c)(1) Of the initial appointments by the Governor:
30	(A) One (1) member shall serve a term of one (1) year;
31	(B) One (1) member shall serve a term of two (2) years;
32	(C) One (1) member shall serve a term of three (3) years;
33	(D) One (1) member shall serve a term of four (4) years;
34	<u>and</u>
35	(E)(i) One (1) member shall be appointed as chair of the
36	commission.

1	(ii) The chair:
2	(a) Is a voting member of the commission; and
3	(b) Shall serve at the pleasure of the
4	Governor and shall not be subject to any term limits;
5	(2) Of the initial appointments by the President Pro Tempore of
6	the Senate:
7	(A) One (1) member shall serve a term of one (1) year;
8	(B) One (1) member shall serve a term of two (2) years;
9	(C) One (1) member shall serve a term of three (3) years;
10	<u>and</u>
11	(D) One (1) member shall serve a term of four (4) years.
12	(3) Of the initial appointments by the Speaker of the House of
13	Representatives:
14	(A) One (1) member shall serve a term of one (1) year;
15	(B) One (1) member shall serve a term of two (2) years;
16	(C) One (1) member shall serve a term of three (3) years;
17	<u>and</u>
18	(D) One (1) member shall serve a term of four (4) years.
19	(4) The appointing authority shall determine the lengths of
20	terms of his or her initial appointees.
21	(5) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(1)(E)(ii) of this
22	section, all succeeding appointments shall be for terms of four (4) years.
23	(d)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (d)(2) of this section, no
24	member of the commission subject to a term limit shall serve more than two
25	(2) terms.
26	(2) Upon the conclusion of his or her initial appointment, an
27	initial appointee to the commission subject to a term limit shall serve no
28	more than two (2) additional terms.
29	(e) Vacancies in the membership of the commission shall be filled for
30	the balance of the unexpired term by the appointing authority.
31	(e)(f) Members of the commission shall be subject to removal from
32	office by the cochairs appointing authority when the actions or condition of
33	a member shall be considered as sufficient cause for removal.
34	$\frac{(f)(g)}{(g)}$ A majority of the commission shall constitute a quorum for the
35	transaction of business.
36	(g)(h) Members of the commission shall serve without compensation but

1	to the extent moneys are appropriated therefor, may receive expense
2	reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.
3	
4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 25-24-102 is amended to read as follows:
5	25-24-102. Duties.
6	The Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission shall have the following duties:
7	(1) To promote racial harmony, understanding, respect, and
8	goodwill among all citizens;
9	(2) To promote principles of nonviolence, peace, and social
10	<pre>justice;</pre>
11	(3) To promote among the people of Arkansas, by appropriate
12	activities, both awareness and appreciation of the civil rights movement and
13	advocacy of the principles and legacy of Martin Luther King, Jr.;
14	(4) To develop, coordinate, and advise the Governor and the
15	General Assembly of appropriate ceremonies and activities throughout the
16	state relating to the observance of Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday,
17	including without limitation providing advice and assistance to local
18	governments and private organizations with respect to the observance of
19	Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday; and
20	(5) To receive donations and contributions from individuals and
21	public and private organizations in order to carry out its responsibilities:
22	(6) To establish a Martin Luther King, Jr. Youth Commission to
23	educate young persons on the principles and legacy of Martin Luther King,
24	Jr.; and
25	(7) To enable the people of Arkansas to reflect on the life and
26	teachings of Martin Luther King, Jr. through educational endeavors, cultural
27	performances, exhibitions, and events that are multiethnic and family
28	oriented.
29	
30	SECTION 3. NOT TO BE CODIFIED. (a) The appointing authorities under
31	§ 25-24-101(b) and (c) shall make their appointments to the Martin Luther
32	King, Jr. Commission within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this
33	act.
34	(b) The terms of the current twenty-six (26) members of the commission
35	shall end upon the appointment of the thirteen (13) members by the appointing
36	authorities under § 25-24-101(b) and (c).

2	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Martin Luther King, Jr.
4	Commission serves an important and valuable role in this state, that the
5	commission requires restructuring to fulfill its functions and advance its
6	goals, and that the ideal time to commence this restructuring is at the
7	beginning of the state's fiscal year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
8	exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
9	health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2009.
