25	SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED	INTO THE ARKANSAS			
26	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. QUARTERLY				
27	REPORTS. Due to the critical role of the Health and Safety and Medical Cost				
28	Containment Programs to the overall programs of the Workers' Compensation				
29	Commission (WCC), the WCC shall provide quarterly reports to the Arkansas				
30	Legislative Council and to the House and Senate Committees on Public Health,				
31	Welfare, and Labor on the progress of the Health and Safety Program and the				
32	Medical Cost Containment Program, in such detail as may be required by either				
33	body. These reports shall be posted on the agency's web page.				
34	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only	y from July 1, 2007			
35	2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

1 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 3 EXPENDITURES. Any expenditure from the Workers' Compensation Commission 4 Building appropriation in this act in an amount exceeding ten thousand 5 dollars (\$10,000) or any combination of expenditures exceeding ten thousand 6 dollars (\$10,000) shall require approval from the Legislative Council. The 7 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is not a severable part of 8 this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is 9 ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire 10 section is void. 11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 12 2007 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010. 13 14 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. INVESTMENTS. All such funds as are held at 15 any time in the Death and Permanent Total Disability Trust Fund, Second 16 Injury Trust Fund, and the Workers' Compensation Fund shall be invested and 17 reinvested to the extent feasible, all such investments as authorized for use by the Office of the Treasurer shall be available to the listed funds. The 18 movement of these funds into and out of investments shall be by fund 19 transfers as directed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Workers' 20 21 Compensation Commission. 22 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 2.3 24 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 25 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 26 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 29 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 30 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 32 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 33 34 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 35 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 36 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations

1	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
2	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
3	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
4	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
5	
6	SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
7	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
8	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
9	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
10	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
11	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
12	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
13	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
14	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
15	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
16	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
