Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ALLOW WITHHOLDING OF UNION DUES FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES; TO REQUIRE COUNTY GOVERNMENTS TO COMPLY WITH AN EMPLOYEE'S REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING OF UNION DUES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO HONOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES, REQUESTS TO WITHHOLD UNION DUES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 14, Subchapter 12 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

14-14-1210. Withholding of membership dues.
(a) As used in this section, "county" means any county in the State of Arkansas.
(b) (1) Effective January 1, 2010, upon receipt of a written request signed by a full-time county employee who is represented by a union or professional association, the county shall withhold membership dues of the union or professional association from the salary of the employee.
(2) The withholding request authorized by this section shall be on a form provided to the employee by the county.
(c) After a withholding request is received by the county and after withholding of an employee's dues is started under subsection (b) of this section, the withholding shall be discontinued only upon receipt of a written notice of cancellation signed by the employee.

[^0]:    (d) The county shall transmit all dues that are withheld under this section to the union or professional association representing the employee within five (5) days of the end of the pay period.
