17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-106-108(b), concerning acceptable*
20 *examinations, is amended to read as follows:*

21 *(b) The State Board of Health shall identify acceptable examinations*
22 *such as those administered by the American Registry of Radiologic*
23 *Technologists, the American Chiropractic Registry of Radiologic Technologists*
24 *with didactic training of a forty-eight-hour program recommended by the*
25 *American Chiropractic Registry of Radiologic Technologists and administered*
26 *by a Diplomate of the American Chiropractic Board of Radiology, or the*
27 *Nuclear Medicine Technology Certification Board.*

29 *SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-106-111(a), concerning exemptions from*
30 *this chapter, is amended to read as follows:*

31 *(a)(1) Dentists, dental hygienists, registered dental assistants with*
32 *the expanded duty of radiography, radiation health physicists, radiation*
33 *medical physicists, chiropractic externs, bone densitometrists, and certified*
34 *medical dosimetrists are excluded from this chapter.*

35 *(2) Any exemptions from the provisions of this chapter are*
36 *exclusive to those enumerated in this subsection.*
