## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to allow students in grade ten (10) OR
ABOVE TO PARTICIPATE IN COSMETOLOGY COURSES
OFFERED IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-26-418(c) concerning cosmetology courses in public schools is amended to read as follows:
(c)(1)(A) Every A person who successfully completes the courses in cosmetology given in a school under the public school system of this state is eligible for a license under this chapter the same as though he or she had graduated from a licensed private school of cosmetology approved by the State Board of Cosmetology.
(B) A student enrolled in grade (10) or above in a public school may participate in courses in cosmetology if offered at the public school he or she attends.
(2) For this purpose, successful Successful completion of courses in cosmetology given in a public schools school that are equal to and the equivalent of the courses required to be given in a licensed private schools school of cosmetology approved by the State Board of Cosmetology board shall be deemed to be the fulfillment fulfill of the requirements of
